FIRE DRILL PROCEDURE

SIGNAL: CONTINOUS BELL RINGS.

PROCEDURE DURING CLASS TIME

- 1. Students exit classroom and WALK in orderly lines.
- 2. Students evacuate the building by designated routs to the Assembly Area (see Fire Evacuation Map.)
- 3. NO TALKING IS PERMITTED!!

4. Teachers:

- a. Take your emergency room red card, green card, and your class roster with you. Your class roster should have the names of those who are present (as well as absent).
- b. Bring your class to assigned zone. Before leaving class, check that all students are out of the classroom.

5. In assigned zone:

- a. Teacher takes attendance of class.
 - If your class is complete, raise room green card.
 - If your class is missing any student, raise room red card.
 - If your class has any extra students/adults/concerns, raise room red card.
- b. Zone Leader (PTA member and/or assigned teacher) will contact GL header or VN header report zone's status.
- 6. If students are with a class other than their own, they are to remain with that class until given permission by zone leader to re-join their "real" class.
- 7. Students remain in orderly and silent lines until the "all-clear" signal is given.

[&]quot;All-clear" signal is a long whistle sound
